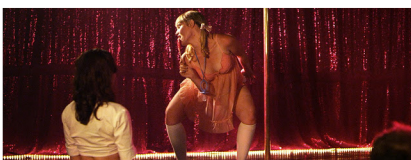

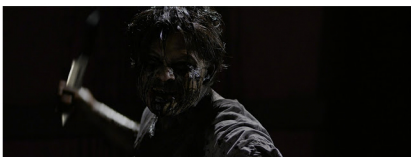

A small town strip club owner named Blue Jean must defend her bar, her strippers and her life when several patrons become increasingly violent and wreak havoc on the final closing night.

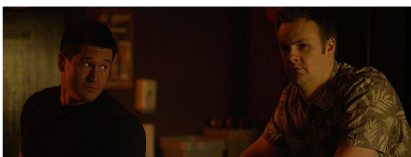
